COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 362, L.D. 979, Bill, "An Act to Fund Rural Outreach Programs, Community Response Programs and Minimum Standard Requirements for Providers of Family Crisis Services Statewide"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
