### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act Regarding Retirement Benefits for Confidential State Employees.



#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. PL 1981, c. 453, §12, sub-§7, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 795, §1, is amended to read:

7. A member, other than an elected or appointed official, who without choice was placed in confidential status with state-paid contributions to the retirement system and retiring after June 30, 1983, and before January 1, 1986, will receive a one-time permanent forward adjustment in retirement benefit as of January 1, 1986, to compensate for the difference in retirement benefits as a result of the pay differential which occurred at the time of change in status. This adjustment will be based upon the member's average final compensation at time of retirement. A member of this class retiring after January 1, 1986, may receive an-adjustment-in-average-final-compensation-based-upon-factors and-a-schedule-approved-by-the-board a one-time permanent forward adjustment in retirement benefits based on the member's average final compensation at the time of retirement.

Sec. 2. PL 1985, c. 795, §2, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 795, §2, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

**Application.** The June 30, 1983, to January 1, 1986, adjustment set out in section 1 shall be applied to average final compensation according to the following schedule:

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### STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill will increase the adjustment in retirement benefits provided to persons in confidential employment status with state-paid contributions who retired after June 30, 1983. This change will compensate these employees for the gross salary differential between the classes of confidential employees.
