21	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

25	Whereas, this legislation needs to take effect immediately to ensure appropriate representation on the Committee to Advise the Department of Human Services on AIDS.

29	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
31	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

35	Further amend the bill by adding before the statement of fact the following:
37	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
