An Act to Prohibit Smoking in Hospitals.

Land of the same

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	22 MRSA §1580-B is enacted to read:
5	§1580-B. Smoking in hospitals
7	 As used in this section, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.
9	A. "Hospital" means any acute care institution required to
11	be licensed pursuant to chapter 405, including the Augusta Mental Health Institute and the Bangor Mental Health
13	Institute.
15	B. "Smoking" means carrying or having in one's possession a lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or other object giving off or
17	containing any substance giving off tobacco smoke.
19	2. Prohibition. No person may smoke tobacco or any other substance in any enclosed area of any hospital, except as
21	otherwise provided in this section.
23	3. Exception. A hospital patient may smoke in designated areas within the hospital if a licensed physician has written an
25	order permitting the patient to smoke.

29	STATEMENT OF FACT
31	The purpose of this bill is to prohibit smoking in Maine hospitals, except by hospital patients on the written order of a
33	physician.
