HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 379,
L.D. 1015, Bill, "An Act Relating to the Director of the Bureau
of Health"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 3rd paragraph
after the title (page 1, lines 23 to 26 in amendment) and
inserting in its place the following:

'The Director of the Bureau of Health must be a licensed
physician or a person eligible for licensure in this State under
Title 32, chapter 48, who is educated and experienced in public
health administration, or a person with an advanced degree in
public health and who has administrative experience.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that a licensed physician with
education and experience in public health or a person with a
graduate degree in public health and who also has administrative
experience may be appointed as Director of the Bureau of Public
Health.
