COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 379, L.D. 1015, Bill, "An Act Relating to the Director of the Bureau of Health"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'22 MRSA §1, as amended by PL 1985, c. 785, Pt. B, §82, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

The Director of the Bureau of Health must be a licensed physician or a person eligible for licensure in this State under Title 32, chapter 48, who is educated and experienced in public health administration and organization.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment requires the Director of the Bureau of Health to be a licensed physician or eligible for licensure by the Board of Registration in Medicine. The intent of the amendment is to protect and further the public health, safety and welfare. If the Director of the Bureau of Health is a person qualified by education and experience in the field of public health, the public will benefit from this expertise.
