An Act Relating to the Director of the Bureau of Health.



1	Be it enacte	d by the	People of	the State	of Maine	as follows:
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22 MRSA §1, as amended by PL 1985, c. 785, Pt. B, §82, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

The Director, Bureau of Health, shall be appointed by the commissioner, subject to review by the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over human resource matters and to confirmation by the Legislature. The director shall be appointed and serve in the unclassified service at the pleasure of the commissioner. Any vacancy in this position shall be filled by appointment as set forth in this paragraph for a like term.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires the appointment of the Director of the Bureau of Health, a position that occupies a sensitive and responsible role in the development of public policy on health issues, to be subject to the legislative confirmation process.
