COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 385, L.D. 1021, Bill, "An Act to Promote Prompt and Peaceful Settlements of Labor Disputes"

Amend the bill in that part designated "\$10." in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "weeks" the following: 'and any party to the labor dispute so requests'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "\$10." in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "has the authority to" and inserting in its place the following: 'shall'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "\$10." by inserting after subsection 2 the following:

'3. Expenses. Members of the fact-finding team, other than any members who are state employees, shall be reimbursed for their actual expenses incurred in performing official duties upon application to the Treasurer of State.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

This bill will require additional General Fund appropriations to cover the expenses and the report of the fact-finding team when a situation arises that would require the appointment of a fact-finding team. Neither the timing nor the amount of the additional appropriations can be determined.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

5 This amendment requires the Governor to appoint a  
7 fact-finding team to investigate the circumstances surrounding a  
9 labor dispute if the dispute lasts longer than 6 weeks and if any  
11 party to the dispute requests the Governor to appoint the team.  
The amendment also provides that members will be reimbursed for  
their actual expenses incurred in serving on the fact-finding  
team and adds a corresponding fiscal note.
