	This amendment requires the Governor to appoint a
5	fact-finding team to investigate the circumstances surrounding a
	labor dispute if the dispute lasts longer than 6 weeks and if any
7	party to the dispute requests the Governor to appoint the team.
	The amendment also provides that members will be reimbursed for
9	their actual expenses incurred in serving on the fact-finding
	team and adds a corresponding fiscal note.
