Т	be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	17-A MRSA §1117 is enacted to read:
5	§1117. Suspension of license
7	Any person who is convicted of a 2nd violation of any provision of this chapter shall, at the discretion of the court,
9	forfeit the right to operate a motor vehicle over the public ways of this State for a period to be fixed by the court at not less
11	than 3 years.

17	The purpose of this bill is to suspend the driver's license
19	of any person convicted of a 2nd violation under this chapter.
