Resolved: 21 there is created the Blue Ribbon Task Force to Promote Equity of 23 Opportunity for Women in the Public School System. force shall consist of 19 members appointed as follows: 25 members of the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate; 4 members of the House of Representatives to be appointed by the 27 Speaker of the House of Representatives, including 2 members of Joint Standing on Education; 2 members to be appointed by 29 the Governor; one representative of the State Board of Education to be appointed by the board; one member of the Maine Human 31 Rights Commission to be appointed by the chair commission; one representative of the Department of Educational 33 and Cultural Services to be appointed by the commissioner of that department; one representative of the Maine Commission for Women 35 to be appointed by the chair of that commission; and the following members to be appointed jointly by the President of the 37 Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives: representative of the Maine School Superintendents Association; 39 one representative of the Maine School Boards Association; one representative of the Maine Teachers Association: 41 representative Teachers; οf the Maine Federation of representative οf the Maine Secondary School Principals' 43 Association; one representative οf the Maine Elementary Principals' Association; and one representative of the Maine 45 Women's Lobby. At the first meeting, the task force shall elect a chair and cochair from among its legislative members; and be it 47 further'
