An Act to Fund and Implement Reclassifications and Collective Agreements with Maine Maritime Academy Employees Represented by the Maine State Employees Association.

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27	STATEMENT OF FACT
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31	The funding provided in this bill results from collective bargaining agreements concerning 3 bargaining units made by the Maine Maritime Academy Board of Trustees and the Maine State
33	Employees Association. During negotiations, comparisons of salary levels of employees at the academy and at the University
35	of Maine at Farmington were made. Through negotiations, it was finally agreed that the amounts contained in this bill are
37	necessary to accomplish wage parity between these 2 institutions. A joint labor and management committee is
39	currently examining each academy classification to determine appropriate individual reallocations.

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
