COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 400, L.D. 1044, Bill, "An Act to Require Written Repair Invoices"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and inserting in its place the following:

'An Act to Amend the Notice Requirement of Car Repair Facilities'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'29 MRSA §2605, last ¶, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 698, §2, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

"We may also charge for our repair services either by the flat rate or "menu price" method. Ask our service advisor to explain what method will be used in charging you and to show you how much it may cost you." '

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to better inform car repair customers as to the different charging methods currently used by Maine dealers and garages. The amendment also removes the provisions in the bill concerning written invoices and diagnostic repairs.
