An Act to Allow Automatic Teller Machines on the Maine Turnpike.

---



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **23 MRSA §1967, sub-§1**, as amended by PL 1983, c. 707, §1, is  
5 further amended to read:

7 1. **Property of the authority.** All property of the  
9 authority and all property held in the name of the State pursuant  
11 to the provisions of this chapter shall be exempt from levy and  
13 sale by virtue of any execution, and no execution or other  
15 judicial process may be a lien upon its property held pursuant to  
17 the provisions of this chapter; provided that the authority shall  
19 not lease, sell or otherwise convey, or allow to be used, any of  
21 its real or personal property or easements therein, franchises,  
23 buildings or structures, with access to any part of the turnpike  
25 or its approaches, for commercial purposes, with the exception of  
such kiosks at rest areas, gasoline filling stations, service and  
repair stations, automatic teller machines and restaurants as it  
deems necessary to service the needs of the traveling public  
while using the turnpike, except that the authority may permit  
the erection or installation of electric power, telegraph,  
telephone, water, sewer or pipeline facilities; and provided also  
that the leasehold interests in such kiosks, gasoline filling  
stations, service and repair stations, automatic teller machines  
and restaurants shall be subject to taxation as provided in  
section 1971.

29 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

31 This bill authorizes the installation of automatic teller  
machines in Maine Turnpike service areas.
