SENATE AMENDMENT "B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 751, L.D. 1055, Bill, "An Act to Restrict Smoking in Enclosed Shopping Malls"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of that part designated "§1672-A." and inserting in its place the following:


'§1672-A. Smoking prohibited

1. Shopping centers; enclosed common areas. Except as provided in subsection 2, smoking is prohibited in any enclosed common area of a shopping center. The managing entity of a shopping center shall post in a conspicuous place a sufficient number of signs indicating that smoking is prohibited. The letters in the sign shall be at least 1 1/2 inches high and proportionally wide.

2. Shopping centers; food or beverage service areas. Smoking in any part of an enclosed common area where food or beverages are served and tables provided shall be governed by section 1579-A.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment prohibits smoking in any enclosed common area of a shopping center. Smoking may be permitted in a designated area where food or beverages are served, consistent with the provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 1579-A, which regulates smoking in restaurants.
