19	'§1672-A. Smoking prohibited
21	1. Shopping centers; enclosed common areas. Except as
23	provided in subsection 2, smoking is prohibited in any enclosed common area of a shopping center. The managing entity of a
25	shopping center shall post in a conspicuous place a sufficient number of signs indicating that smoking is prohibited. The
27	letters in the sign shall be at least 1 1/2 inches high and proportionally wide.
29	2. Shopping centers; food or beverage service areas. Smoking in
31	any part of an enclosed common area where food or beverages are served and tables provided shall be governed by section 1579-A.

37	STATEMENT OF FACT
39	This amendment prohibits smoking in any enclosed common area of a shopping center. Smoking may be permitted in a designated
41	area where food or beverages are served, consistent with the
43	provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 1579-A, which regulates smoking in restaurants.
