COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 751, L.D. 1055, Bill, "An Act to Restrict Smoking in Enclosed Shopping Malls"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'22 MRSA §1672-A is enacted to read:

§1672-A. Smoking prohibited

Smoking is prohibited in any enclosed common area of a shopping center. The managing entity of a shopping center shall post in a conspicuous place a sufficient number of signs indicating that smoking is prohibited. The letters in the sign shall be at least 1 1/2 inches high and proportionally wide.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment prohibits smoking in any enclosed common area of a shopping center.
