

Amend the amendment in section 2, in subsection 3 by striking out all of the last sentence (page 1, lines 36 to 39 in amendment).

Further amend the amendment in section 3, in subsection 3 by striking out all of the last sentence (page 2, lines 1 to 4 in amendment).
