COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 758, L.D. 1062, Bill, "An Act to Enhance the Economic Corridor Action Grant Program"

Amend the bill by striking out all of subsection 3 (page 1, lines 30 to 39 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'3. Municipal eligibility. The Department of Economic and Community Development may make grants to municipalities within economic growth corridors in support of capital investments in public service facilities or projects which support economic growth and development. Following the applicable date set forth in Title 30-A, section 4343, subsection 1, any municipality within an economic growth corridor is eligible to apply for grants under this article when it has adopted a comprehensive plan in accordance with the requirements of Title 30-A, chapter 187, subchapter II.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill will allow the Office of Community Development within the Department of Economic and Community Development to implement the Economic Corridor Action Grant Program and to spend \$1,000,000 appropriated for this purpose in fiscal year 1988-89 by Public Law 1987, chapter 816.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment corrects the references in the bill to refer to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A and adds a fiscal note.
