### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Require All Major Health Care Insurers Doing Business in Maine to Reimburse for Routine Physical Examinations and Screenings.
