25	STATEMENT OF FACT
27	The purpose of this amendment is to ensure that at least 2 of the members of the commission to study problems with the
29	municipal assessment, valuation and collection of property taxes represent high-valuation communities, that is, communities which
31	receive 0 to 25% of their school costs through the state education funding formula.
