HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 776,
L.D. 1088, Bill, "An Act to Provide Comprehensive Property Tax
Relief"

Amend the amendment in Part E in section 1 by adding after
the 2nd sentence a new sentence to read: 'The President of the
Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall
ensure that at least 2 of the commission members represent
communities which receive 0 to 25% of their school costs through
the state education funding formula.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to ensure that at least 2
of the members of the commission to study problems with the
municipal assessment, valuation and collection of property taxes
represent high-valuation communities, that is, communities which
receive 0 to 25% of their school costs through the state
education funding formula.
