IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Exempt Certain Lands Classified as Wetlands under Local Ordinances.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 38 MRSA §436-A, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 815, §§3 3 and 11, is amended to read: 5 5. Freshwater wetlands. "Freshwater wetlands" means 7 freshwater swamps, marshes, bogs and similar areas which are: 9 Α. Of 10 or more contiguous acres; and 11 в. Characterized predominantly by wetland vegetation. Freshwater wetlands may contain small inclusions of land that do 13 not conform to the criteria of this subsection. 15 Areas which otherwise meet the definition of freshwater wetlands 17 but which are determined by the municipality to be of no benefit to wildlife, ground water replenishment, plant habitat or flood control due to soil type and location shall not be considered 19 freshwater wetlands for the purpose of this chapter. This determination shall be made by the municipality in its 21 comprehensive plan. 23 25 STATEMENT OF FACT 27

This bill exempts from state-mandated local zoning and 29 subdivision regulation freshwater wetlands that are determined by a municipality to be of no benefit to wildlife, ground water replenishment, or flood 31 plant habitat control. This determination is to be made by the municipality in its comprehensive plan. 33

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
