27	(1) For deputy sheriffs, "full-time" means employment with the reasonable expectation of earning at least
29	\$10,000 in any one calendar or fiscal year for performing law enforcement duties.

33	Further amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec 2.'

41	This amendment makes a technical correction to the bill by amending the Maine Criminal Justice Academy law to reflect the \$10,000 annual income limit established by the bill for part-time
