STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Increase the Compensation for Part-time Deputy Sheriffs.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

30-A MRSA §386, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 737, Pt. A, §2 and Pt. C, §106 and as amended by PL 1989, cc. 6 and 9, is further amended to read:

7 2. Part-time deputies. Part-time deputies shall \mathbf{be} compensated at a reasonable rate established by the county 9 commissioners, which may not exceed the lowest per diem compensation rate of a full-time deputy in the county. No part-time deputy may be compensated under this section more than 11 \$6,000 <u>\$10,000</u> in any one calendar or fiscal year. Incidental 13 expenses as are necessary for the proper enforcement of the laws shall also be paid in the same manner as provided for full-time 15 deputies and are not included in the \$6,000 <u>\$10,000</u> limitation on compensation. Compensation paid to a part-time deputy for 17 serving as a court officer is not included in the \$6,000 \$10,000 limitation on compensation.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill raises the compensation limitation for part-time deputies from \$6,000 to \$10,000.
