**An Act to Strengthen the Law Pertaining to Taking or Defacing
Political Campaign Signs.**



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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

23 MRSA §1913-A, sub-§7 is enacted to read:

7. Penalty. A person who takes, defaces or disturbs a political campaign sign under subsection 1, paragraph H, commits a Class E crime.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill makes taking, defacing or disturbing a political campaign sign a Class E crime.
