STATEMENT OF FACT

27

This amendment modifies the bill by exempting all-terrain vehicles from inappropriate sections of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29, including those referring to titles, inspections, motor vehicle repair, and for-hire passenger and freight carriers. Nevertheless, if an all-terrain vehicle is registered for highway use, it is a motor vehicle and all the provisions of Title 29 apply.
