An Act to Make Certain Motor Vehicle Laws Applicable to All-terrain
Vehicles.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 29 MRSA §1, sub-§7, as amended by PL 1985, c. 539, §2, is
5 further amended to read:

7 7. Motor vehicle. "Motor vehicle" means any self-propelled
9 vehicle not operated exclusively on tracks, but not including
11 snowmobiles as defined in Title 12, section 7821, and all-terrain
13 vehicles as defined in Title 12, section 7851, unless the
15 all-terrain vehicle is registered for highway use by the
Secretary of State under this Title. Notwithstanding any other
provision of law, whenever an all-terrain vehicle is operated on
a way as defined in section 1, subsection 21, then that
all-terrain vehicle shall be subject to all provisions of this
Title, except chapters 5, 7 and 9.

21 This bill makes certain provisions of the motor vehicle laws
23 applicable to the operators of all-terrain vehicles when such
vehicles are operated on ways.
