17	Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:
19	'An Act to Allow Municipal Clerks to Inspect Sample Ballots before
21	Election Day'
23	Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in
25	its place the following:
27	'Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §606, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:
29	2-A. Sample ballots. The Secretary of State shall affix a sealed envelope containing samples of each type of ballot packed
31	inside to the outside of every package or box of ballots sent to a voting place. The Secretary of State shall authorize
33	preparation of the sample ballots which shall be printed concurrently with the regular ballots. A sample ballot must be
35	substantially the same as the type of ballot it exemplifies, except that:

39	A. The words "SAMPLE BALLOT" in bold type and the name of the voting district must be printed on each sample ballot.
41	B. The facsimile of the signature of the Secretary of State must not be printed on a sample ballot.
43	C. A sample ballot must be incapable of being cast using a
45	voting machine or electronic voting system.
