31	I. Unless listed or described in another schedule, all narcotic drugs, including, but not limited to, heroin
33	(diacetylmorphine), methadone, pethidine, morphine and opium. <u>As used in this chapter, "heroin" means any</u>
35	compound, mixture or preparation containing heroin.
37	Sec. 3. 17-A MRSA §1103, sub-§4, as amended by PL 1987, c. 535, §2, is repealed.
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41	Sec. 4. 17-A MRSA §1106, sub-§4, as amended by PL 1987, c. 535, §5, is repealed.'
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45	STATEMENT OF FACT
47	This amendment clarifies the definition of heroin, and removes unnecessary and possibly conflicting definitions of cocaine and heroin in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 17-A,
49	chapter 45.
