17	Amend the bill in that part designated "§454." by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting in its place the following:
19	
21	'2. Tampering with a witness or, informant or juror is a Class C crime. Tampering with a victim is a Class B crime.'
23	Further amend the bill by striking out all of subsection 4 and inserting in its place the following:
25	14 Nebuithebuiling subscription 2 when the methods arised
27	'4. Notwithstanding subsection 2, when the most serious charge or charges against the defendant include murder or a Class A crime, tampering with the victim of any crime charged or a
29	juror involved in the criminal proceedings is a Class B crime.'
31	STATEMENT OF FACT
33	
35	This amendment makes tampering with a juror a Class C crime, raising it one class from current law. If the defendant in the proceeding is charged with murder or a Class A crime, tampering
37	with a victim or a juror is a Class B crime.
