HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 808, L.D. 1120, "RESOLUTION,  
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Provide  
for 4-Year Terms for Senators and Representatives"

Amend the resolution in the first paragraph after the first  
amending clause, in the 5th line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by  
striking out the following: "1990" and inserting in its place  
the following: '1994'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment provides that Senators and Representatives  
will serve 4-year terms beginning with the general election held  
in 1994. By 1994, the federal census data will have been  
compiled and printed and legislative districts will have been  
drawn to more accurately reflect population centers.
