COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 815, L.D. 1127, Bill, "An Act to Enhance the Status of Vocational-technical Education in Maine"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 91. Implementation. The costs of implementing the name change provided in this Act for activities such as replacing stationary, forms and brochures and rewording signs shall be phased in as existing supplies are exhausted and as available resources permit. The cost to individual campuses shall be paid from funds available to the campus and the cost to the system office shall be paid from available system office funds.

FISCAL NOTE

The Maine Vocational-Technical Institute System will be able to implement the name changes proposed by this bill without additional General Fund appropriations. The additional costs will be phased in and absorbed within the existing resources of each campus and the system office.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that implementation of the name change for the Maine Vocational-Technical Institute System called for in the original bill will be implemented within existing resources and adds a fiscal note to the bill.
