Amend the amendment in that part designated "§6434." in
subsection 3 in the last line (page 1, line 48 in the amendment)
by inserting after the underlined word "owner" the following:
'unless with written permission from the licensed owner'

traps or other gear may authorize another person to fish those
traps by giving the other person written permission.
