IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act Dealing with Removal of Dislodged Lobster Gear.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA §6434, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661, $\S5$, is amended to read:

§6434. Molesting gear

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It shall be unlawful for any person, except a coastal 9 warden, the licensed owner or a person having written permission from the licensed owner, to raise, lift, transfer, possess or in 11 any manner molest any lobster trap, warp, buoy or car. This section shall not apply to the removal of any lobster trap, warp, 13 buoy or car that is dislodged and is found above the mean low tide mark. 15

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill amends the law prohibiting the molestation of lobster gear by allowing the removal of dislodged or otherwise damaged lobster gear from property above the mean low tide mark.
