SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 420, L.D. 1131, Bill, "An Act to Prohibit Injurious Hazing of Public School Students"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

This bill will require local school boards to adopt policies and penalties to deter hazing and to distribute copies of these policies and penalties to all students enrolled in public schools. In doing so, local school units will incur additional costs which would qualify for 100% state reimbursement under Public Law 1987, chapter 821, during the first 2 years of this requirement. While the cost to individual school units will not be significant, an additional General Fund appropriation will be required to pay for the statewide total of these local costs. However, the amount of the appropriation cannot be determined at this time.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

The purpose of this amendment is to add a fiscal note to the bill.
