25 27	Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

29	'FISCAL NOTE
31	Enactment of this legislation may result in an increased number of filings throughout the State's court system. The
33	Judicial Department has indicated that it can absorb the additional costs within its resources.'

37	STATEMENT OF FACT
39	This amendment applies the prohibition established by the bill to the 1000 foot zone surrounding elementary, vocational and
11	secondary schools, but not colleges, junior colleges, universities or any other post-secondary school.
13	
15	This amendment also includes school buses as a "zone" in which drug trafficking is an aggravated offense.
