IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Criminalize Sexual Abuse of Patients by Psychiatrists and Psychologists.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 1 3 Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §253, sub-§2, ¶H is enacted to read: H. The actor is a psychiatrist or psychologist and the 5 other person, not the actor's spouse, is a patient of the 7 actor. For purposes of this paragraph, if the actor professes to be a psychiatrist or psychologist to the other 9 person, the actor will be treated as such even if the actor is not a psychiatrist or psychologist. 11 Sec. 2. 17-A MRSA §253, sub-§5, as amended by PL 1985, c. 495, 13 <sup>§7</sup>, is further amended to read: Violation of subsection 2, paragraph A, C or E is a 15 5. Class B crime. Violation of subsection 2, paragraph B, D, F  $\Theta \mathbf{F}_{L}$ G or H is a Class C crime. 17 1.9STATEMENT OF FACT 21 23 This bill makes it a Class C crime for a psychiatrist, a psychologist or someone masquerading as a psychiatrist or a psychologist, to engage in either sexual intercourse or a sexual 25 act with a person, other than a spouse, who is concurrently the 27 psychiatrist's, psychologist's or charlatan's patient. It is not intended to prohibit this conduct once the professional

29 relationship is at an end.
