HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 825, L.D. 1157, Bill, "An Act
to Reduce the Quantities of Cocaine and Heroin Necessary to Allow
a Presumption of Unlawful Furnishing"

Amend the bill by striking out all of subsection 3 and
inserting in its place the following:

'3. A person shall be presumed to be unlawfully furnishing
a scheduled drug if he the person intentionally or knowingly
possesses more than 1 1/2 ounces of marijuana, 14 7 grams or more
of cocaine or 14 2 grams or more of heroin.'
