## **FISCAL NOTE**

II It is anticipated that the Department of Marine Resources and the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife would absorb all cost associated with the establishment of rules defining "fish kill." Also, this bill could result in additional cases filed in the state court system. However, the Judicial Department would absorb any additional costs utilizing existing resources.'

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment broadens the scope of the original bill to 23 make it a violation for improper operation of a fishway which results in a fish kill. The Department of Marine Resources and 25 the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall jointly make rules to define "fish kill." The penalty shall equal the 27 value of the fish killed but not exceed \$10,000 each day the violation continues.
