IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Make Hydropower Project Operators Financially Responsible for Fish Kills.



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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

38 MRSA §349, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1983, c. 796, §18, is further amended to read:

2. Civil penalties. Any person who violates any provision 7 of the laws administered by the department or terms or conditions of any order, regulation, license, permit, approval or decision 9 of the board shall be subject to a civil penalty, payable to the State, of not less than \$100 nor more than \$10,000 for each day of that violation or, if the violation relates to hazardous 11 waste, of not more than \$25,000 for each day of the violation. 13 In addition, any person whose violation of the terms or conditions of any order, regulation, license, permit, approval or decision of the board pursuant to sections 630 through 637 15 results in a fish kill, shall be subject to a forfeiture, payable 17 to the State, of the revenue attributable to the hydropower project on the day the fish kill occurred.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill amends the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, section 349, subsection 2, to impose an additional civil penalty on the operators of hydropower projects whose violations of the law result in fish kills.
