The following funds are appropriated from the 3 General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act. 5 1989-90 7 HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF 9 **Bureau of Maternal and Child** Health 11 13 All Other \$84,000 J.5 Provides funds to the Women, Infant and Children's Program for the administration of 17 services. 1.9 STATEMENT OF FACT 21 This bill provides funding for the Women, Infant and 23 Children's Program, which offers nutritional education, health eligible assessments, referrals and supplemental food to 25 households. These funds will be used for the administration of services, in order to maintain the State's current level of 27 services.
