An Act to Amend the Family Planning Services Act.



#### 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

22 MRSA §1906, as amended by PL 1975, c. 293, §4, is further amended to read:

#### §1906. Availability

To the extent family planning funds are available, the Department of Human Services shall provide family planning services to medically—indigent persons of low income who are determined eligible for such services as—determined by rules and regulations promulgated by the Commissioner of Human Services. Family planning services shall also be available to all others who are unable to reasonably obtain these services privately, at

who are unable to reasonably obtain these services privately, at a reasonable cost to be determined by the rules and-regulations promulgated by the commissioner. Any funds so collected shall be

17 retained by the department for the support of these services.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill is intended to clarify the Department of Human Services' authority to promulgate rules establishing income thresholds under which individuals may receive public assistance for the payment of family planning services, including medically accepted contraceptive procedures. These thresholds may exceed those established for determining Medicaid eligibility.
