An Act to Promote Clean Air in Beano Halls.

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	17 MRSA §314-C is enacted to read:

7	<u>The Chief of the State Police shall not issue a license to operate a beano or bingo game unless:</u>
