19	Amend the amendment by inserting after section 100 the following:
21	'Sec. 101. Statutory referendum procedure; submission at statewide election; form of question; effective date. This Act shall be submitted
23	to the legal voters of the State of Maine at a statewide election to be held on the Tuesday following the first Monday of November
25	following passage of this Act. The city aldermen, town selectmen and plantation assessors of this State shall notify the
27	inhabitants of their respective cities, towns and plantations to meet, in the manner prescribed by law for holding a statewide
29	election, to vote on the acceptance or rejection of this Act by voting on the following question:

33	"Shall the State assume management and control over local and county jails?"
35	The legal voters of each city, town and plantation shall vote by ballot on this question, and shall designate their choice
37	by a cross or check mark placed within a corresponding square
39	below the word "Yes" or "No." The ballots shall be received, sorted, counted and declared in open ward, town and plantation
	meetings and returns made to the Secretary of State in the same
41	manner as votes for members of the Legislature. The Governor
43	shall review the returns and, if it appears that a majority of the legal voters are in favor of the Act, the Governor shall
	proclaim that fact without delay, and the Act shall become
45	effective 30 days after the date of the proclamation.
47	The Secretary of State shall prepare and furnish to each city, town and plantation all ballots, returns and copies of this
49	Act necessary to carry out the purpose of this referendum.'
