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#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Amend the Pollution Abatement Grants Program.

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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38 MRSA §411, first  $\P$ , as amended by PL 1987, c. 751, §12, is further amended to read:

The department may pay an amount not to exceed 80% of the 7 expense of a municipal or quasi-municipal pollution abatement construction program or a pollution abatement construction program in an unorganized township or plantation authorized by 9 the county commissioners. The department may make payments to the Maine Municipal Bond Bank to supply the State's share of the 11 revolving loan fund established by Title 30, section 5171-A. The 13 department may pay up to 90% of the expense of a municipal or quasi-municipal pollution abatement construction program or a 15 pollution abatement construction program in an unorganized township or plantation authorized by the county commissioners or a privately owned pollution abatement construction program 17 required and undertaken as a result of a license renewal denial 19 under section 464, subsection 4, paragraph G in which the construction cost of the project does not exceed \$100,000 as long as total expenditures for the small projects do not exceed 21 \$1,000,000 in any fiscal year and not more than one grant is made to any applicant each year, except that the department may pay up 23 to 50% of the expense of individual projects serving seasonal dwellings or commercial establishments. The application for a 25 grant under this paragraph for a project serving a single-family 27 dwelling, including outbuildings, or а single commercial establishment, shall include a signed statement of the financial 29 condition of the owner of the single-family dwelling or commercial establishment describing the need for the grant. That 31 statement will become part of the application record and no further evidence of need will be required.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make persons who are denied renewals of their overboard discharge licenses eligible for the pollution abatement grants program.
