An Act Amending the Guidelines for the Elderly Householders Tax and Rent Refund Program and the Elderly Low-cost Drug Program.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 1 Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §6206, sub-§§1 and 2, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 3 516, S3 and 6, are amended to read: 5 · 1. 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STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the income eligibility levels under the household tax and rent refund law as
they apply to elderly households and under the elderly low-cost drug program in the same proportion as exists in the current
eligibility levels.
