COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 869, L.D. 1208, Bill, "An Act to Create a New Crop and Livestock Research and Development Program"

Amend the bill in the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting at the beginning the following: "Sec. 1."

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires a General Fund appropriation to the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources, Agricultural Production, Acct.#01101.5, in the amount of \$80,000 for fiscal year 1989-90 and \$120,000 for fiscal year 1990-91. This appropriation would provide for research and development on new and existing types of livestock and crops. Also, the above mentioned funding to implement this proposal is included in the Governor's supplemental budget bill, Legislative Document 640.'
