HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 882,
L.D. 1226, Bill, "An Act to Assure Access to Nutrition Programs
for Kindergarten and Part-day Students"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the
first paragraph after the title and before the statement of fact
and inserting in its place the following:

Further amend the bill in subsection 1 in the 3rd line from
the end (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following:
"shall" and inserting in its place the following: 'may'

Further amend the bill in subsection 1 by inserting at the
end the following: 'Costs associated with providing kindergarten
and other part-day students a meal that meets the requirements of
the National School Breakfast Program must be fully reimbursed by
the State. When fees are permissible for those breakfasts,
schools shall charge and collect a fee for each reduced-price
breakfast that is equal to the maximum fee permitted under
federal law and a fee 5¢ above that maximum for each full-price
breakfast. The money collected through those fees must be used
by schools to offset the costs of providing breakfasts under this
subsection.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated
from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires the State to fully reimburse qualifying
12 local school units for the net costs of participating in the
National School Breakfast Program for kindergarten and part-day
14 students. It also requires schools that choose to participate to
charge fees that are permissible under federal law for
16 reduced-price and full-price breakfasts. The money collected
must be used to offset the costs of providing the breakfasts.' '

STATEMENT OF FACT

22

This amendment removes the requirement that schools
participate in the National School Breakfast Program and requires
24 that the State fully reimburse qualifying schools that choose to
participate in the program. The amendment replaces the fiscal
26 note and appropriation.
