4	This bill requires that all public schools participate in
	the National School Breakfast Program. As a result of the state
6	mandate law, the State is required to pay 100% of the additional
	costs incurred during the first 2 years of the mandate. After
8	the first 2 years, these additional costs will be paid through
	the school subsidy formula. The maximum future additional
10	appropriations required are \$48,570 in fiscal year 1991-92, and
	\$31,250 in fiscal year 1992-93 and thereafter. However, the
12	State's cost would be reduced to the extent that school units
	exercise the option of collecting meal fees from students who are
14	eligible for reduced price or full price meals.'
